## Periodontal

The generalized horizontal bone level is 1-2 mm apical to the CEJ.

There is evidence of vertical bone loss of 19M.

There is no evidence of furcation involvement.

No overhanging margins are evident.

There is mesial drifting and tipping of 19 and 18.
