The portrayed borders of the paranasal sinuses appear to be intact; there is no evidence of pathosis in these sinuses.

The airway appears patent, but there is evidence of moderate adenoidal hyperplasia.

Portions of the first through third cervical vertebrae are depicted. No gross abnormalities are seen. There is a normal width of prevertebral soft tissue.

The generalized bone pattern and jaw morphology are within the range of normal.
